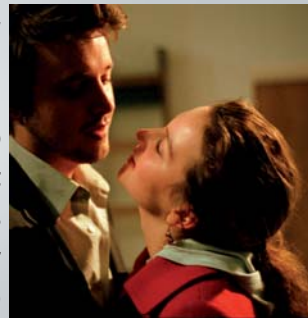


My Daughter, Her Guy and Me
